

Pardon Project of Washington County

Eligibility Criteria

DRAFT of 6-22-2021

- A criminal record and/or residence in Washington County
- Household income at or below 187% of the federal poverty guideline
- At least 3 years have passed since *completion* of most recent sentence; exception: 10 years must have passed from the date of completion of sentence for any crime involving registration of the offender under SORNA or any of the following crimes (in such cases, admission into program will be on a case-by-case basis):
 - Rape.
 - Any felony involving sexual conduct.
 - Robbery.
 - Robbery of a motor vehicle.
 - Aggravated assault.
 - Kidnapping.
 - Voluntary manslaughter.
 - Murder.
 - Arson.
 - Attempt, conspiracy or solicitation to commit the above crimes.
- An individual with a record based on alcohol or substance use must have at least three years of sobriety, supported by documentation of successful treatment or other reliable proof if requested
- No open criminal prosecution
- Full payment of amount due in restitution (not including fines, court fees and costs) is possible within 30 months (that is, by the time of the pardon hearing)
