We help remove legal barriers so our clients can focus on rebuilding their lives, strengthening their families, and moving forward with confidence.

How We Can Help

Child Custody

We can represent you in court if you lost custody or visitation rights before you were in recovery.

Child Support

We can represent you or provide guidance for court if your child support rights or responsibilities were affected before you were in recovery.

Housing

We can represent you if you are being evicted, illegally locked out, or your utilities are shut off, and we can help you if your housing conditions are poor.

Criminal Record Clearing

We can help eligible clients clear or seal criminal records to make it easier to find a job, housing, or other opportunities.

Consumer Protection & Debt

We can represent you in court if you are being sued for a debt, and we can advocate for you and provide guidance to help you relieve debt.

Additional Services

We may also connect you with other legal services offered by Summit Legal Aid, including:

- Driver's license restoration
- Public benefits, including health care coverage and other assistance while in recovery
- Housing discrimination if you have been denied housing because of your past addiction

Who Can Receive Services?

To qualify for this program, you must:

- Live in Greene County,
- Meet income eligibility, and
- Have at least 90 days of recovery from drug or alcohol use

You can show proof of your recovery by providing one of the following:

- Meeting slips showing you completed "90 meetings in 90 days" or participated in a similar recovery program.
- A certificate showing you successfully completed an inpatient, outpatient, or residential treatment program.
- A letter from a counselor, recovery coach, sponsor, meeting leader, or recovery house owner or manager confirming your sobriety and commitment to recovery.
- Other documents that show you have been in recovery for at least 90 days and are approved by the County Drug Treatment Court.
